OUR APPROACH

These are the skills that will serve each student the most in every subject for the entirety of their academic career. Content areas such as history and science become the laboratories where students get to practice and master their core skills while they enjoy more active learning. Biblical truth is integrated throughout the curriculum and our teachers challenge students to dig deeper and answer questions using higher-level thinking.

OUR PROGRAM

DCA’s educational program prioritizes Bible, English language arts and mathematics as core instruction. These content areas are taught in the morning hours when student learning is the most productive. Our students also enjoy a variety of enrichment classes like art, fitness, and music. Our late day instruction is when students enjoy more hands-on learning such as science and history labs. Additionally, our 1st-5th grade students receive individualized support in reading through our WIN (What I Need) program, which is focused on strengthening areas of needed improvement as well as sharpening strengths through higher level development. Students who need additional support also have the opportunity to work with a Reading Intervention Specialist teacher in individualized or small group instruction. We conduct regular benchmark assessments to help teachers make informed instructional decisions in the classroom in order to ensure student growth.
